

## Facts at a Glance – Fiscal Year 2005-06

The Cumberland Regional Health Care Center (CRHCC) provides service to 33,000 residents of the county, involving communities from Advocate Harbour to the Pugwash area as well as to neighboring residents of Westmorland County, New Brunswick. The Hospital employs more than 300, making it one of the largest employers in the county.

### At present the complement of specialists at the CRHCC includes:

- 4 full-time equivalent surgeons
- 3 full-time anesthetists
- 2 obstetrician-gynecologists
- 1 ENT
- 3 internists
- 2 Ophthalmologists
- 1 Neurologist (part-time)
- 1 Palliative Care specialist

### Facilities at CRHCC include:

- 2 state-of-the-art operating rooms and a small procedure; third OR construction commenced June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2006 and opened in August 2006.
- 65 beds

### In 2005-2006, there were:

- 25,446 outpatient/ambulatory care visits – **up 36.82%** over the previous year
- 20,009 emergency room visits – **up 1.5%** over the previous year (4.7% were New Brunswick patients)
- 712,528 laboratory in-house procedures – **up 12.3%** over the previous year
- 20,637 total patient days
- 27,941 diagnostic imaging tests
- 7,674 ECG department tests
- 194 births

From 04-05 to 05-06 there has been a **63.4% increase** in the number of inpatient OR cases and an **18.7% increase** in day surgery procedures here at CRHCC.

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### Patient Repatriation Program

The Cumberland Health Authority has also embarked on a repatriation program, which will bring Cumberland County residents back to the area after receiving services elsewhere. This program has been very effective. In fiscal 2005-2006, ninety-nine Cumberland County patients were repatriated back to a facility equaling 2607 total patient days. 45 patients went to the CRHCC, totaling 733 patient days; while 51 patients repatriated to All Saints Hospital, totaling 1501 patient days.
